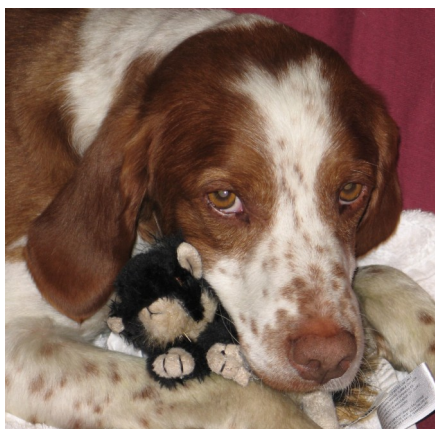

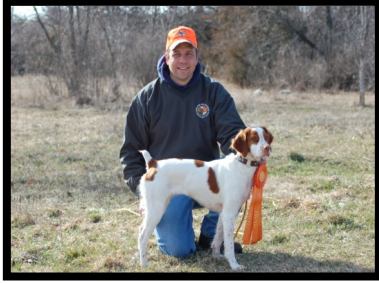
We will need everyone's help with these TWO raffles this year.

GMBC Spring Horseback Field Trial Bong Recreation Area, Kansasville, WI



It's spring again, and the start of the Field Trial season. The GMBC Spring field trial is just around the corner, April 9-10, at the Bong Recreation Area in Kansasville, WI. We are really hoping for some new faces to come out and run their dogs.

My name is Richard Lamb, and I am the clubs new 1st VP for Field Trialing. Since joining the club in 2003, I have seen a lot of energetic, dramatic, and independent running dogs in our club. I am hoping to see more of these dogs run in our annual field trials.

For this years spring trial we will have 6 stakes, Open Puppy, Open Derby, Open Gun dog, Amateur Gun Dog, Open All-Age, and Amateur All-Age. For those new to field trailing, the Puppy and Derby stakes are juvenile stakes (dogs do not have to be steady to wing and shot) much like the 'juniors' stake in a Hunt Test. The Gun dog and All-Age stakes are for the dogs trained to be steady, or 'broke'. Even though this is a 'horseback' trail, horses are **OPTIONAL!** I can say that I have walked many braces in these trails and even brought home some ribbons.

Our Spring trail also hosts a 'Happy Hour' where we provide catering for our club and field trial guests. The club provides the main course and we are looking for club members to make a dish to pass. This means that we must receive your check at least 60, (preferably 90), days prior to your renewal date. This will make sure that you don't miss any magazines.

I will try to post renewals 3 months in advance. Remember, you can renew up to 3 yrs. at a time. I would highly recommend this option so that you don't miss any magazines.

GMBC prices were last raised as of January 2005 to \$35 full and \$10 assoc. (please note). This reflects increases by ABC and also increases for insurance, postage, etc.

Note: Please renew through me for GMBC membership because if you send your payment directly to ABC (because you received their yellow card in the mail), I won't know about it for at least 6 months since they are very slow with getting updated membership info to me; and then you will still owe the club \$5 to be a full member of GMBC. (They charge \$30 for national club and we charge \$35 to be a member of the National Club PLUS Regional Club (GMBC). The EXTRA \$5 gets you a lot...GMBC newsletter, hunting/field trial training sessions, fun field trials, picnic, banquet, and awards. Whereas "\$30 national only membership" just gets you the ABC magazine (which is included with GMBC membership as well).

ACT 90 "Puppy Mill" Bill Update

As you may know, ACT90, commonly known as the "Puppy Mill" Bill passed unanimously in late 2010.

The advisory board, which I am a member of, met many times in approximately eight months to draft the "minimal standards of care" which is now ATCP 16. ATCP 16 relates to the licensing and regulation of dog dealers, breeders, dog breeding facilities, animal control facilities and animal shelters.



The Agriculture, Trade & Consumer Protection Board held a hearing in November and with a few minor changes, approved ATCP 16 to move forward in the process.

Presently, ATCP is before the Senate and Assembly. They have several options beyond passage of the Rules (ACTP 16) and we are waiting to see how they will choose to proceed. With so many new legislators in office, it is difficult to know what will happen but without the passage of ATCP16, the Bill (ACT90) has nothing enforceable.

First, unless you sell at least 25 dogs, from more than 3 litters, a year, this bill will NOT affect you.

Also, this does not affect you unless if you are a "dog dealer" who sells at least 25 dogs in a year that you did not breed and raise.

I sincerely believe that anyone taking reasonable care of their dogs has nothing to fear from the Bill.

I attended a large meeting with opinions ranging from stating it was "common sense" to the other opinion of not liking the Rules. But this was from a person who tethers (which is allowed) his dogs year round and boasts that he cleans and levels the dog area twice a year (no other cleanup) with a bobcat. He stated that he already gets complaints.

I think it's fair to tell you that there is an active group who does not support the Bill. I believe they have that right but I have read and attended meetings where they give a very negative interpretation to the Rules which I believe builds fear and inaccurate information in the dog community.

An example in the Rules states the dogs to have "potable water free of contamination". Potable means drinkable. This group stated that by putting antibiotics in the water contaminated it and your dogs could be seized. These statements are absurd and totally without merit!

I would prefer that people have the facts and then decide for themselves how they feel about the information. To that end, I will forward to anyone the entire document and you can let me know of any areas of concern. It's not difficult reading, just lengthy.



Lately, the area of greatest concern is the PRIMARY ENCLOSURE sizes. This is about the floor space where the dog lives and there are two sets. One for dogs getting at least 30 minutes of exercise a day and the other for 120 minutes of exercise a day. What is proposed is minimally larger than what has been the USDA Regulations for at least 17 years.

The opposition group is using fiberglass crate sizes as the acceptable floor space usage even though the crates are for transportation and temporary housing of dogs for the sizes given on the labels. It's not that crates can't be used; they just need to be of sufficient size for dogs living in them 23 hours a day.

Again, I will forward the draft to anyone contacting me. If you have heard information and have questions or concerns, please give me a call.

Subject: RBFTA Meeting

Here are some thoughts from the wildlife side of things:

* **Controlled burn plans for this spring: Loop 3, possible loop 2, and foot trail area. Plan on burning loop 3 as part of the continued sweet clover control program. Would like to burn loop 2 as well if it that is possible. The foot trail area is on the list, but depends on budget.**

* **Will continue to spray sweet clover patches in loop 2 & 3 after burning this spring and summer. What like to promote the idea of having sweet clover pulling party this summer. One day prior to the plants going to seed where a group effort is made to pull individual and small groups of plants. These small groupings can be dealt easily and will prevent the wide spread of the clover.**

* **Black Locust in Loop 3: Looking at the re-growth and it does not look bad at all. A few sprouts here and there that will easily be treated with herbicide. In January the plan is to treat the standing Black Locust using a hypo hatchet. It is a hatchet attached to a container that delivers the herbicide directly into the cut. The plan is to treat w/ transline the trees and kill them. Then have them cut down in the future. This will hopefully eliminate any re-sprouts. It has been used on other parts of the property with great success.**

* **Also for this month planning cutting the cattails in the Cigar Pond and working on the willows.**

* **Working on the NAVHDA project on \$4 flowage.**
